Bulk program supply for domestic Canada and export markets. Contract specs confirmed by lot IDs and documentation.

Supply model	Contract grower supply; cleaned/graded/packed near origin; allocated to Bennett's Seed for final sales	Typical uses	Semolina and pasta, couscous, milling

Typical Buyer Contract Parameters (Set by Buyer, Confirmed by Lot)

- Grade: CWAD No. 1 / No. 2 / No. 3 (as contracted)
- Protein: per contract target (method and basis defined in contract)
- Test weight: target aligned to grade and buyer requirement (kg/hL)
- HVK (vitreousness): grade determinant and buyer target (%)
- Moisture: contract maximum
- Dockage / foreign material: contract maximum
- Optional: falling number, mycotoxin screens, residues, other buyer-required tests (by request)

Packaging, Logistics & Documentation

Packaging

- Bulk (program-dependent)
- 25 kg bags
- 1 MT totes

Shipping terms

- FOB / CIF / DAP (by contract)

Documentation

- Lot IDs (shipment-level traceability)
- Packing list, B/L, commercial invoice
- COA / analysis summary (on request)
- Destination-aligned export docs (as required)
